### TERMS & CONDITIONS

**PAYMENT:** A \$500 deposit is required to hold a reservation. The tour cost is based on payment by personal check or Zelle (direct bank transfer). There is a 3% surcharge for credit card use.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** If a written cancellation notice is received beyond 90 days before departure, a full refund less \$500 applies. If a notice is received within 90 days of departure, \$500 plus any funds retained by the airline, hotels, and bus companies are non-refundable.

**ITINERARIES:** Daily itineraries are prepared in advance and are subject to change.

**BAGGAGE & SEATING ON PLANE:** Only a small carry-on bag is included in the cost. The cost of a suitcase (maximum of 50 pounds) to check-on the plane may or may not be an extra cost. Reserved Seating is normally assigned at check-in, with an option to purchase a seat ahead.

**DOCUMENTATION:** Passengers must have a government-issued valid passport (with up to 6 months left from the trip return date). Beginning October 2026 an ETIAS travel authorization is required for Portugal. It can be obtained online by going to <https://travel-europe.europa.eu/en/etias> for approximately 7 Euros - \$10 USD.

**SINGLE ROOMS:** Costs are based on two people in a room. Single rooms are available at cost.

**MEALS:** Meals are pre-arranged at the hotels.

**AIR CARRIER RESPONSIBILITY:** The airlines cannot be held responsible for any act, omission, or event when passengers are not on board the plane. The airlines, as international carriers, are subject to international conventions limiting their liability; the limitations of liability contained on the passenger's airline ticket shall constitute the sole contract between the airlines and the passenger under the conditions stated on the ticket. 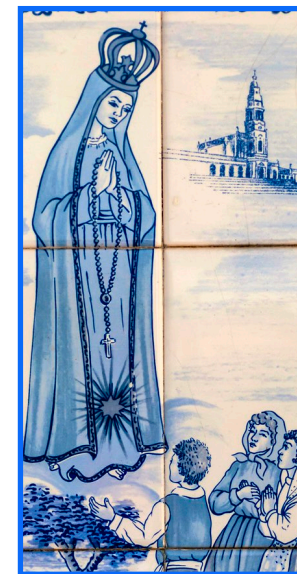

## DAY 1-4

**Oct. 10, 2026 - Day 1 - Saturday**

Afternoon flight departure from San Francisco to Lisbon, Portugal.

**Day 2 - Sunday - FATIMA** - Afternoon arrival in Lisbon. Transfer to Fatima for check-in at our hotel for four nights. Orientation tour of the Sanctuary ~ the holy grounds (Cova d'Iria) where five Marian apparitions took place from May to October of 1917 to St. Jacinta & St. Francisco Marto and Ven. Lucia Santos. See the Basilica and Capelinha overlooking a large esplanade over the shepherds' fields (apparition site).

**Day 3 - Monday - FATIMA** Travel to the hamlet of Aljustrel to see the homes of the Fatima seers. Take in the unspoiled beauty of the olive groves, passing by places of heavenly visitation (Valinhos/Loca Cabeco). An evening Rosary & Candlelight procession on the Sanctuary Square opens the anniversary celebration.

**Day 4 - Tuesday - FATIMA** One hundred and nine years ago, on Oct. 13, 1917, Mary appeared here for the final time and performed a miracle of the sun, witnessed by over 70,000 people, both skeptics and believers alike. It was reported in the New York Times the next day. Join pilgrims worldwide at the shrine for the anniversary events, culminating in a stirring procession as the faithful wave white handkerchiefs in a farewell *Adieu* to the Blessed Mother.

**Day 5-Wednesday- ATLANTIC** First stop at the 14th-century Gothic Monastery of Batalha, built to thank

the Blessed Virgin for protection in a battle that ensured Portugal's freedom. Mid-day arrival in the Atlantic fishing village of Nazare, set above the highest sea cliff in Europe. Visit a 14th-century shrine built to house a miraculous image of Mary nursing the Child Jesus with 1st century roots.

**Day 6-Thursday-BRAGA** Depart for Portugal's beautiful, verdant northern region, for the ancient city of Braga. Upon arrival and check-in at our hotel (2 nights), visit the mountaintop shrine of Bom Jesus with a 15th-century baroque double staircase embellished with statues depicting the virtues; a real catechism in stone.

**Day 7-Friday-TUI/PONTEVEDRA** Daytrip across the border into Galicia, Spain, where Lucia, the oldest of the Fatima seers, lived as a Dorothean postulant and later a professed sister (1925-1929), before becoming a Carmelite. Here, she received heavenly visions fulfilling the Fatima promises (the Immaculate Heart and the 1st Saturdays). Return to Braga.

**Day 8- Saturday - BALAZAR - SANTAREM** Check-out of our hotel and head to Balazar to visit the home and parish church of Blessed Alexandrina, known as the "Fourth Seer of Fatima". Discover the life of one of the greatest mystics of modern times, who lived on the Blessed Sacrament alone for 13 years.

## DAY 9-10

Continue south to Santarem - the sight of a 13th-century Eucharistic Miracle—evening arrival in the Old World maritime capital of Lisbon. Check into our hotel for two nights.

**Day 9- Sunday - DAY IN LISBON** Due to its strategic location, Lisbon was the hub of the 15th-century Age of Exploration. Visit the church over St. Anthony's birthplace(1195), the Se Cathedral, Jeronimos Monastery and the former orphanage that Jacinta of Fatima stayed at before she died in a Lisbon hospital. Drive on the River Tagus, stopping at the Monument of the Discoveries. Evening Farewell Dinner.

**Day 10 - Monday** Morning transfer to Lisbon Airport for our return flight to SFO (or our home city).
